2011 Senate Bill 30

Senate Bill 30 requires that if a 1st class city imposes a residency requirement on police officers or fire fighters, it must allow residency to be within the county in which the 1st class city is located and within any county that is adjacent to the county in which the 1st class city is located.

Senate Amendment 1

Senate Amendment 1 to Senate Bill 30 maintains the provisions of the bill, but moves the language from the general statute on residency for officials in a 1st class city to the specific statute governing police and fire departments in a 1st class city.

Legislative History

Senate Amendment 1 was introduced and adopted by the Senate Committee on Labor, Public Safety and Urban Affairs, on February 28, 2012, on a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2. That same day, the vote to recommend passage of the bill, as amended, failed on a vote of Ayes, 2; Noes, 3.
