**SENATE AMENDMENT 10,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 40**

June 20, 2013 – Offered by Senators ERPENBACH, WIRCH, RISSER, T. CULLEN, MILLER, LEHMAN, VINEHOUT, L. TAYLOR, SHILLING, HARRIS, HANSEN, LASSA, C. LARSON and SCHULTZ.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute  
2           amendment 1, as follows:

3           **1.** Page 213, line 15: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by  
4           \$171,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$491,600 for the  
5           purpose of paying administrative costs of providing Medical Assistance benefits to  
6           certain adults with incomes up to 133 percent of the poverty line.

7           **2.** Page 213, line 17: decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by  
8           \$25,894,300 and decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$91,760,000  
9           for the purpose of providing Medical Assistance benefits to certain adults with  
10          incomes up to 133 percent of the poverty line.

11          **3.** Page 214, line 5: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by  
12          \$315,600 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$1,110,700 for

1 the purpose of paying administrative costs of providing Medical Assistance benefits  
2 to certain adults with incomes up to 133 percent of the poverty line.

3 **4.** Page 582, line 5: delete “100” and substitute “133”.

4 **5.** Page 582, line 5: delete the material beginning with “before application” and  
5 ending with “(4m)” on line 6.

6 **6.** Page 582, line 16: delete “100” and substitute “133”.

7 **7.** Page 582, line 17: delete the material beginning with “before application”  
8 and ending with “(4m)” on line 18.

9 **8.** Page 597, line 19: after that line insert:

10 “**SECTION 1091e.** 49.471 (1) (cr) of the statutes is created to read:

11 49.471 (1) (cr) “Enhanced federal medical assistance percentage” means a  
12 federal medical assistance percentage described under 42 USC 1396d (y) or (z).”.

13 **9.** Page 599, line 24: delete that line and substitute:

14 “49.471 (4) (a) 4. b. ~~Except as provided in subd. 4. c., the~~ The individual’s”.

15 **10.** Page 599, line 25: delete “100” and substitute “133”.

16 **11.** Page 600, line 1: delete the material beginning with “before application”  
17 and ending with “(d)” on line 2.

18 **12.** Page 600, line 21: after that line insert:

19 “**SECTION 1100g.** 49.471 (4) (a) 8. of the statutes is created to read:

20 49.471 (4) (a) 8. Subject to sub. (4g) and notwithstanding sub. (4) (a) 4. or s.  
21 49.45 (23), an adult who is under 65 years of age; who is not pregnant; who is not  
22 otherwise eligible for Medical Assistance under this paragraph or s. 49.46 (1); and  
23 whose income, as determined under the method described in 42 USC 1396a (e) (14),

1 does not exceed 133 percent of the poverty line for a family the size of the individual's  
2 family.”.

3 **13.** Page 601, line 18: after that line insert:

4 “SECTION 1107k. 49.471 (4g) of the statutes is created to read:

5 49.471 (4g) MEDICAID EXPANSION FEDERAL MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PERCENTAGE. For  
6 services provided to individuals described under sub. (4) (a) 8., the department shall  
7 comply with all federal requirements to qualify for the highest available enhanced  
8 federal medical assistance percentage. The department shall submit any  
9 amendment to the state medical assistance plan, request for a waiver of federal  
10 Medicaid law, or other approval required by the federal government to provide  
11 services to the individuals described under sub. (4) (a) 8. and qualify for the highest  
12 available enhanced federal medical assistance percentage.”.

13 **14.** Page 601, line 19: delete the material beginning with that line and ending  
14 with page 603, line 17.

15 **15.** Page 1385, line 17: after “(1)” insert “(cr) and”.

16 **16.** Page 1385, line 18: delete “and 5.” and substitute “5., and 8.”.

17 **17.** Page 1385, line 18: before “(6)” insert “(4g),”.
