**SENATE AMENDMENT 13,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 40**

June 20, 2013 – Offered by Senators VINEHOUT, WIRCH, HARRIS, LEHMAN, MILLER, RISSER, C. LARSON, LASSA, HANSEN and L. TAYLOR.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
2 amendment 1, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 213, line 15: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by
4 \$171,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$491,600 for the
5 purpose of paying administrative costs of providing Medical Assistance benefits to
6 certain adults with incomes up to 133 percent of the poverty line.

7 **2.** Page 213, line 17: decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by
8 \$25,894,300 and decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$91,760,000
9 for the purpose of providing Medical Assistance benefits to certain adults with
10 incomes up to 133 percent of the poverty line.

11 **3.** Page 213, line 17: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by
12 \$12,000,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$12,000,000

1 for the purpose of providing moneys for comprehensive community services to
2 support people with mental illness and substance abuse disorders.

3 **4.** Page 213, line 17: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by
4 \$12,000,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$12,000,000
5 for the purpose of exempting nursing facility beds that are considered institutions
6 for mental disease beds from the nursing home licensed bed assessment.

7 **5.** Page 214, line 5: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by
8 \$315,600 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$1,110,700 for
9 the purpose of paying administrative costs of providing Medical Assistance benefits
10 to certain adults with incomes up to 133 percent of the poverty line.

11 **6.** Page 329, line 12: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2013–14 by
12 \$37,500,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2014–15 by \$37,500,000
13 for the purposes for which the appropriation is made.

14 **7.** Page 582, line 5: delete “~~200~~ 100” and substitute “200”.

15 **8.** Page 582, line 5: delete the material beginning with “before application” and
16 ending with “(4m)” on line 6.

17 **9.** Page 582, line 16: delete “100” and substitute “200”.

18 **10.** Page 582, line 17: delete the material beginning with “before application”
19 and ending with “(4m)” on line 18.

20 **11.** Page 597, line 19: after that line insert:

21 “**SECTION 1091e.** 49.471 (1) (cr) of the statutes is created to read:

22 49.471 (1) (cr) “Enhanced federal medical assistance percentage” means a
23 federal medical assistance percentage described in 42 USC 1396d (y) or (z).”.

1 **12.** Page 599, line 24: delete that line and substitute:

2 “49.471 (4) (a) 4. b. ~~Except as provided in subd. 4. c., the~~ The individual’s”.

3 **13.** Page 599, line 25: delete “200 100” and substitute “200”.

4 **14.** Page 600, line 1: delete the material beginning with “before application”
5 and ending with “(d)” on line 2.

6 **15.** Page 600, line 21: after that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 1100g.** 49.471 (4) (a) 8. of the statutes is created to read:

8 49.471 (4) (a) 8. Subject to sub. (4g) and notwithstanding sub. (4) (a) 4. or s.
9 49.45 (23), an adult who is under 65 years of age; who is not pregnant; who is not
10 otherwise eligible for Medical Assistance under this paragraph or s. 49.46 (1); and
11 whose income, as determined under the method described in 42 USC 1396a (e) (14),
12 does not exceed 133 percent of the poverty line for a family the size of the individual’s
13 family.”.

14 **16.** Page 601, line 18: after that line insert:

15 “**SECTION 1107k.** 49.471 (4g) of the statutes is created to read:

16 49.471 (4g) **MEDICAID EXPANSION FEDERAL MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PERCENTAGE.** For
17 services provided to individuals described in sub. (4) (a) 8., the department shall
18 comply with all federal requirements to qualify for the highest available enhanced
19 federal medical assistance percentage. The department shall submit any
20 amendment to the state Medical Assistance plan, request for a waiver of federal
21 Medicaid law, or other approval required by the federal government to provide
22 services to the individuals described in sub. (4) (a) 8. and qualify for the highest
23 available enhanced federal medical assistance percentage.”.
