



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 286**

March 20, 2014 – Offered by Representative STEINEKE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 20, line 8: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 18m.** 118.38 (1g) of the statutes is created to read:

4 118.38 **(1g)** (a) A school board may request the department to waive the
5 requirement under s. 118.425 (4) (a) to close a school or contract under s. 118.40 with
6 a person to operate the school as a charter school if the school is the only elementary,
7 middle, junior high, or high school operated by the school district. The department
8 shall submit the request to the academic accountability council for its
9 recommendation.

10 (b) If a waiver is granted under this subsection, the school board shall take all
11 of the actions required of the school board and operator of the charter school under

1 s. 118.425 (4) (b) 1. and 2. and the new principal of the school shall determine the
2 teachers employed for the school, subject to s. 118.425 (4) (b) 2.

3 (c) Notwithstanding sub. (3), a waiver granted under this subsection is
4 permanent.”.

5 **2.** Page 25, line 7: after “(d)” insert “and s. 118.38 (1g)”.

6 **3.** Page 25, line 15: after “shall” insert “issue a request for proposals and
7 publish a class 1 notice under ch. 985 within 30 days of the department’s
8 determination under par. (a). The school board shall”.
