Current law requires the governor to take actions during the 2011-13 and 2013-15 fiscal biennia to ensure that \$582,200 is lapsed from the general purpose revenue appropriations to the office of the governor in each of those fiscal biennia. This bill eliminates that requirement for the 2013-15 fiscal biennium.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

**SECTION 1.** [2011 Wisconsin Act 32](#), section [9219 \(1u\)](#) is amended to read:

[\[2011 Wisconsin Act 32\]](#) Section 9219 (1u) APPROPRIATION LAPSES AND REESTIMATES. The governor shall take actions during the 2011-13 and 2013-15 fiscal biennia fiscal biennium to ensure that from general purpose revenue appropriations

to the office of the governor under section 20.525 of the statutes an amount equal to \$582,200 is lapsed from sum certain appropriation accounts or is subtracted from the expenditure estimates for any other types of appropriations, or both, in each that fiscal biennium.
