Hi Mike-

We'd like an amendment drafted for the Assembly and Senate versions of this proposal to correct a related issue. The amendment should direct the cosmetology board to identify the regional and national accrediting agencies (it already keeps track of these) that serve our schools. Any school in the country accredited by either a regional or national accrediting agency identified by the board shall then have its cosmetology curricula recognized in Wisconsin, similar to what is done with other licensed professions.

Currently, no formal process exists for those who come to Wisconsin having been educated with enough hours to meet hour requirements, but have not been licensed in another state. This should fix that problem. The jackets for these have been delivered to the clerks offices but the bills do not appear to have been numbered yet—should happen soon. Please let me know if you have questions. Have a great weekend!

Currently, a license for cosmetology or barbering generally requires that the applicant studied at a school licensed under subch. IV of ch. 440 (barbering and cosmetology schools). Is the intent of the amendment to allow the cosmetology board and DSPS (for barbers) to license applicants who have studied at a school that is not licensed under subch. IV of ch. 440 if the school is accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the board or DSPS, as appropriate?

Representative Knudson:

Please review this draft carefully to ensure that it is consistent with your intent.

Note that the presiding officer in the Assembly may find that this amendment is not germane to 2013<sup>v</sup>AB 503. AB 503, as noted in that bill's relating clause, relates to "cosmetologist training hours and exemption of makeup artists from barbering and cosmetology licensure requirements." This amendment relates to authorizing applicants for licensure as a barber, cosmetologist, aesthetist, manicurist, or electrologist to satisfy instruction requirements at schools accredited by an accrediting agency approved by DSPS or the Cosmetology Examining Board, as appropriate, in addition to schools licensed under subch. VI of ch. 440. I have amended the relating clause in the bill to reflect the inclusion of provisions relating to accredited schools.
