

WHEREAS, Mr. LaPorte passed away on February 17th, 2013, at the age of 91; and

WHEREAS, Mr. LaPorte was born to Sicilian immigrants who came to Milwaukee in 1904; but raised his family in Waukesha after serving in World War II; and

WHEREAS, Mr. LaPorte served as a city of Waukesha alderman for five total terms and mayor for one term; and Milwaukee County Supervisor for one term; and

WHEREAS, Mr. LaPorte and his wife Marion founded and operated their popular restaurant and tavern, LaPorte's Tap, which served customers from all over the area; and

WHEREAS, Mr. LaPorte and his dedicated service to Waukesha will always be remembered and valued by all residents of past, present and future; now, therefore, be it
