**Intent:**

Establish a new, continuing appropriation from which DWD may award grants to public and private organizations for costs related to customized workforce training. DWD should have the authority to establish procedures and criteria for the review and award of grants, establish reporting requirements, and conduct audits and inspections of grant recipients. There should be a requirement for matching funds as a condition of receiving a grant, but the match percentage is not known at this time.

It is not known at this time whether or not priorities or minimum/maximum award amounts will be identified in statute.

**EMPLOYMENT**

Current law requires DWD to establish a statewide workforce investment system to meet the employment, training, and educational needs of persons in this state; to plan, coordinate, administer, and implement a youth apprenticeship program and such other employment and education programs as the governor may assign to DWD; and to make grants to persons providing employment and training activities to dislocated workers.

This bill requires DWD to award grants to public and private organizations for the development and implementation of customized workforce training programs (training grants). The bill permits DWD to require a public or private organization, as a condition of receiving a training grant, to provide matching funds at a percentage to be determined by DWD. The bill also grants to DWD all powers necessary and convenient to implement the training grant program, including the power to: 1) promulgate, by rule, procedures and criteria for awarding training grants; 2) receive and review applications for training grants and to prescribe the form, nature, and extent of the information that must be contained in an application for a training grant; 3) audit and inspect the records of training grant recipients; and 4) require reports from training grant recipients as needed.
