Intent:

Establish a new, continuing appropriation from which DWD may award grants to public and private organizations for costs related to customized workforce training. DWD should have the authority to establish procedures and criteria for the review and award of grants, establish reporting requirements, and conduct audits and inspections of grant recipients. There should be a requirement for matching funds as a condition of receiving a grant, but the match percentage is not known at this time.


It is not known at this time whether or not priorities or minimum/maximum award amounts will be identified in statute.

SECTION 1.	20.445	1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

20.445 (1) (b) Customized workforce training program. As a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule for the customized workforce training program under s. 106.27.

****NOTE: This SECTION involves a change in an appropriation that must be reflected in the revised schedule in s. 20.005, stats.

SECTION 2. 106.27 of the statutes is created to read:

106.27 Customized workforce training program. (1) Grants. From the appropriation under s. 20.445 (1) (b), the department shall award grants to public and private organizations for the development and implementation of customized workforce training programs. As a condition of receiving a grant under this subsection, the department may require a public or private organization to provide matching funds at a percentage to be determined by the department.

- (2) IMPLEMENTATION. The department shall have all powers necessary and convenient to implement this section, including the power to do all of the following:
- (a) Promulgate, by rule, procedures and criteria for awarding grants under sub.(1).
- (b) Receive and review applications for grants under sub. (1) and to prescribe the form, nature, and extent of the information that must be contained in an application for a grant under sub. (1).
 - (c) Audit and inspect the records of grant recipients.
