Mark,

Section 5 of SB 121 is a fiscal change to increase the amount of funding appropriated for skills enhancement grants. Because the biennial budget act repeals and recreates the appropriation schedule under s. 20.005 (3), stats., if language similar to section 5 of AB 121 becomes law before enactment of the budget act and the budget act does not include the funding, the effect of the budget will be to eliminate the funding provided for in your draft. I guess I should have started by asking to what fiscal years would you like to increase funding for these grants? Are you trying to get an increase for the remainder of this fiscal year or are you looking ahead to the 2013-15 fiscal biennium?

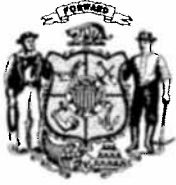
