Please review the attached draft carefully to ensure that it is consistent with your intent.

This is a redraft of 2011 LRB-2764/1. I have updated dates and, because of the timing of the bill (the bill is being prepared early in the session), I have had to make other adjustments. Because the biennial budget act repeals and recreates the appropriation schedule under s. 20.005 (3), stats., if this bill becomes law before enactment of the budget act, the budget act will eliminate the appropriation funding in this bill. To avoid this result, I have provided for an effective date that is not earlier than the biennial budget act. I have also provided funding in both fiscal years of the biennium. Finally, I have updated language in the rule-making provisions of the bill, bill sections 4 (1) to (3). Because the program depends on DOT rule making, the rule-making provisions of the bill provide for expeditious rule-making procedures and eliminate potential delays. In other words, rule-making procedures and timelines will be similar to those that existed prior to the rule-making changes in 2011 Wisconsin Act 21.

Please let me know if you would like any changes made to the attached draft or if you have any questions. If the attached draft meets with your approval, let me know and I will convert it to an introducible "/1" draft.
