Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill makes several changes to Chapter 59 of the statutes, which summarizes the legal status, power and duties of Milwaukee County, the County Board and its officers. The Department is unable to estimate the local fiscal impact of these changes.
