Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill increases the forfeiture for a violation of the law restricting unsolicited telephone contact for the purpose of encouraging the recipient of the telephone call to purchase property, goods, or services.

Prosecutors have very few referrals for violations this law; consequently, they anticipate that enactment of this law will have no fiscal impact on their offices.

Prosecutors do not expect any long-range fiscal impact if this bill is enacted.
