Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill requires a local unit of government to publish a class 2 notice at least 30 days before a public meeting regarding the application for a frac sand mine. In addition, it requires a local unit of government to send written notice of a meeting about the application for a frac sand mine at least 30 days in advance to the owner or occupant of any land that is located within one mile of the proposed mine. The bill specifies that these notification steps must be taken before the local unit of government can take any action on an application for the mine.

Local Fiscal Impact

Local units of government would incur increased costs for publishing class 2 newspaper notices, which are estimated at \$250 each. In addition, local units of government would incur costs from complying with the requirement to mail meeting notices to land and property owners that are in proximity to a proposed mine.
