<b>Description</b> Notice requirements for zoning actions related to frac sand mining					

### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Senate Bill (SB) 138 changes zoning law requirements for cities, towns and counties to require that before a political subdivision can take action on an application for frac sand mining, the subdivision must publish a class 1 notice at least 30 days before the meeting where the application will be considered, and must send a written notice of the meeting to each land owner or land occupant that is located within one mile of the proposed mine. The bill also provides a definition of frac sand.

The publishing costs and mailing costs incurred by the political subdivision to meet the notice requirements of the bill are indeterminate. The Department cannot determine how many applications for frac sand mining would be received by municipalities or how many land owners or occupants of land would be entitled to a mailed notice.
