SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 191

November 5, 2013 – Offered by Senator LASSA.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 1, line 3: after "evidence" insert "and granting rule-making
3	authority".
4	2. Page 2, line 14: after that line insert:
5	"SECTION 2g. 173.12 (4) of the statutes is created to read:
6	173.12 (4) (a) The department may promulgate rules regarding temperament
7	testing of dogs that have been seized because it is alleged that they have been used
8	in or constitute evidence of any crime specified in s. 951.08.
9	(b) The department may promulgate rules regulating the rehabilitation of dogs
10	that have been seized because it is alleged that they have been used in or constitute
11	evidence of any crime specified in s. 951.08.
12	SECTION 2r. 173.12 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

173.12 (5) A person who in good faith rehabilitates a dog that has been seized
because it is alleged that the dog has been used in or constitutes evidence of any crime
specified in s. 951.08 is immune from civil liability for damages caused by the dog.".
