Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Current law requires the Legislative Audit Bureau to conduct a program evaluation audit of WEDC's economic development programs every two years. This requirement is unchanged by the provisions of Senate Bill 193.

Current law also requires the Bureau to conduct a financial audit of WEDC every two years. Senate Bill 193 requires the Bureau to annually conduct a financial audit of WEDC and a performance evaluation audit of WEDC's policies and management practices.

It is difficult to accurately estimate the costs of conducting these audits until planning and scheduling work is completed to determine the scope of each audit. It is likely that conducting these audits would reduce the flexibility of the Joint Legislative Audit Committee to direct the Bureau to complete other audits and evaluations.
