Please review the attached draft carefully to ensure that it is consistent with your intent.

This is a redraft of 2011 SB-432 and I have included the same appropriation reduction amount (\$878,200) that appears in 2011 SB-432. This amount may no longer be an accurate estimation, and I recommend consulting DOT or LFB to determine whether an updated figure is necessary.

I also note that, in November 2014, the state's electorate will vote on ratifying a constitutional amendment to prohibit transfers from the transportation fund. See 2013 Assembly Joint Resolution 2 (AJR-2). If AJR-2 is ratified by the voters, it will nullify the transfer provisions in s. 85.57 of this bill.

Please let me know if you would like any changes made to the attached draft or if you have any questions. If the attached draft meets with your approval, let me know and I will convert it to an introducible "/1" draft.

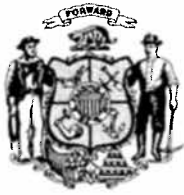

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Transportation (DOT) issues two registration plates for most motor vehicles. The owner of the motor vehicle must display one plate on the front of the vehicle and one plate on the rear of the vehicle.

This bill directs DOT to issue only one registration plate for most motor vehicles. With limited exceptions, the registration plate must be displayed on the rear of the motor vehicle.

Under current law, moneys may not be transferred from the transportation fund to any other fund.

This bill requires that, beginning in fiscal year 2014-15, the secretary of administration transfer from the transportation fund to the general fund an amount in each fiscal year equal to the savings realized in the change to a single registration plate for motor vehicles.

For further information see the **state** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
