Hi Mike and Cathlene,

On behalf of Representative Kerkman and Senator Cowles, I am requesting identical amendments to LRB-2441/1 and LRB-2442/1 that do all of the following:

- 1 ✓ On Page 14, line 1, delete "assist the chairperson to".
- 2 ✓ In SEC 35, delete the definition of "nonprofit organization" beginning on Page 14, Line 16. On Page 14, Line 22; Page 14, Line 24; and Page 15, Line 2, after "organization", add, ", private foundation, or similar entity".
- 3 ✓ On Page 14, Line 23 and Page 15, Line 5, replace references to the Chief Executive Officer with references to the Board.
- 4 ✓ Add the phrase "allocation of a tax benefit" in ss. 23.167 (2) (c), 36.09 (1) (am) 3., 38.04 (1m) (b) 3., 41.11 (1g) (b) 3., 84.01 (6m) (b) 3., 93.07 (18) (b) 3., and 234.032 (2) (c), Stats., in a manner analogous to the amendment in SEC 33 of the bill.
- 5 ✓ Add the phrase "allocated tax benefits" in ss. 23.167 (2) (e), 36.09 (1) (am) 5., 38.04 (1m) (b) 5., 41.11 (1g) (b) 5., 84.01 (6m) (b) 5., 93.07 (18) (b) 5., and 234.032 (2) (e), Stats., in a manner analogous to the amendment in SEC 34 of the bill.

Instead, add a provision that requires the WEDC Board to adopt procurement policies and procedures that specify all of the following: (a) when WEDC is required to publicly solicit proposals from multiple vendors; (b) how WEDC will evaluate proposals from multiple vendors; and (c) how WEDC will assess potential conflicts of interest a vendor may have if the vendor sells goods or services to WEDC. (Amendment 3 to 2013 Assembly Bill 181 is the model for this, but without the tie to any particular program).

10. Modify SEC 30 to specify that the members who are members of the Assembly and members of the Senate shall serve either a 6-year term or until they are no longer in office, whichever is shorter.

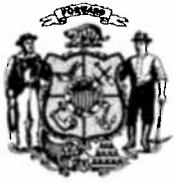

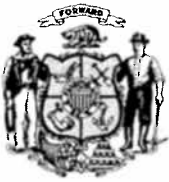
