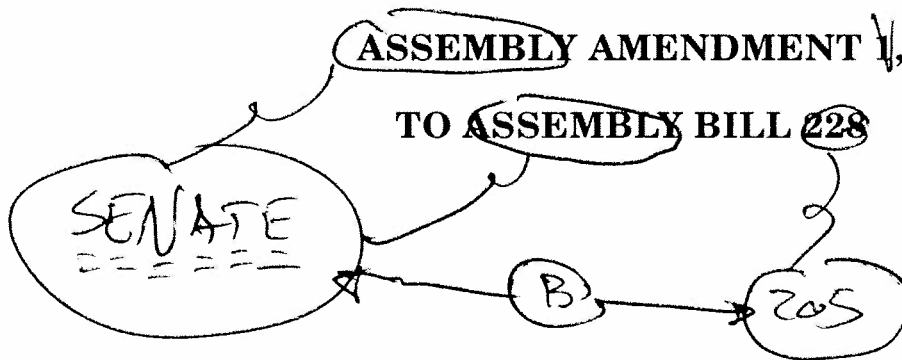

2 **1.** Page 14, line 4: after that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 32m.** 238.02 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 238.02 (3) A chief executive officer shall be nominated by the governor, and

5 with the advice and consent of the senate appointed, to serve at the pleasure of the

6 governor. The board may delegate to the chief executive officer any powers and

7 duties the board considers proper. The chief executive officer shall receive such

8 compensation as may be determined by the board. The chief executive officer and

9 any executive employee of the corporation shall have financial management

10 experience, municipal or regional economic development experience, or private

11 sector business experience."
