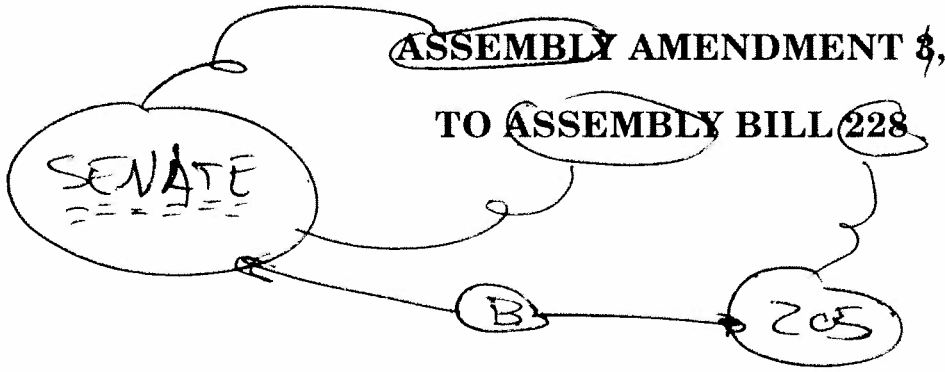

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2 **1.** Page 14, line 4: after that line insert:
- 3 **"SECTION 32g.** 238.02 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 4 238.02 (3) A chief executive officer shall be nominated by the governor, and
- 5 with the advice and consent of the senate appointed by the board, to serve at the
- 6 pleasure of the governor board. The board may delegate to the chief executive officer
- 7 any powers and duties the board considers proper, except any power to appoint or
- 8 terminate the employment of any executive employee of the corporation. The chief
- 9 executive officer shall receive such compensation as may be determined by the board.
- 10 **SECTION 32r.** 238.02 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 11 238.02 (4) All powers and duties assigned to the corporation under this chapter
- 12 shall be exercised or carried out by the board, unless the board delegates the power
- 13 or duty to an employee of the corporation. The board may not delegate to an employee

1 of the corporation any power to appoint or terminate the employment of any
2 executive employee of the corporation.”
