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

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 2: delete "offences" and substitute "offenses".

3 **2.** Page 2, line 3: after "jurisdiction" insert "and making an appropriation".

4 **3.** Page 7, line 15: after that line insert:

5 "SECTION 18m. 301.26 (7) (a) of the statutes, as affected by 2013 Wisconsin Act  
6 20, is amended to read:

7 301.26 (7) (a) For community youth and family aids under this section,  
8 amounts not to exceed \$45,478,000 for the last 6 months of 2013, \$90,956,100 for  
9 2014, and \$45,478,100 \$47,978,100 for the first 6 months of 2015.".

**"SECTION 64g. Nonstatutory provisions.**

Page 20, line 5: after that line insert:

1 (1) FUNDING CHANGES. In submitting information under section 16.42 of the  
2 statutes for purposes of the 2015-17 biennial act, the department of corrections shall  
3 identify any funding increases or decreases attributable to the provisions of this act.

4 **SECTION 64r. Fiscal changes.**

5 (1) COMMUNITY YOUTH AND FAMILY AIDS. In the schedule under section 20.005  
6 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of corrections under  
7 section 20.410 (3) (cd) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 2013, the dollar  
8 amount is increased by \$2,500,000 for the second fiscal year of the fiscal biennium  
9 in which this subsection takes effect to increase funding for the provision of juvenile  
10 delinquency-related services for juveniles 17 years of age.”.
