Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Senate Bill 340 expands the type of authorized raffles in Wisconsin to include games of chance for which tickets are sold and that use plastic or rubber ducks in a race. The bill also imposes specific requirements for conducting the race. The Department anticipates there would be an increase in license applications as a result of this legislation. However, it is difficult to quantify the number of organizations that would apply for a license under this bill.

Senate Bill 340 also proposes eliminating the word "drawing" in a number of places throughout Chapter 563 of State Statutes and by doing so may actually change the meaning of a number of statutory provisions. Removing this language may have the unintended consequence of legalizing other forms of gambling not envisioned by the bill (i.e. Golf Ball Drops, Paddle Wheels, etc.) This would further increase the number of applications received by the Division.

The Division of Gaming would be unable to absorb the workload involved with an increase in applications and would require an additional 1.0 FTE position to work in coordination with the 1.0 FTE position currently working with the raffle applications to process applications and respond to inquiries. The estimated annual cost of this position is \$74,200. Additionally, there will be one-time costs of \$79,500 to update the charitable database program, revise forms and documents and complete initial printing of the updated forms and documents.

Current application fees are \$25 for each raffle license. The Division of Gaming processed approximately 9,500 applications in fiscal year 2012-13, resulting in revenue of \$239,000. In order to provide the revenue necessary to support the position, an increase of approximately 3,000 applications per year or an increase in the application fee would be required.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

The amount of increased revenue as a result of increased applications is indeterminate. There would be on-going costs associated with the workload of 1.0 FTE position.
