Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under the bill, county and tribal agencies receiving GPR funds for the purpose of home visiting services, are required to use informational materials prepared by the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board relating to the risks of cosleeping while intoxicated with an infant. A copy of the board's printed materials must be shared with families receiving home visiting services along with an oral explanation by the home visiting worker regarding what the materials mean. The bill allows the board to meet the requirement for providing the information to home visiting agencies via the board's Internet site. As a result, agencies will be able to download the information to be shared with families receiving home visiting services.

This additional activity on the part of home visitation workers will be added to the list of information shared with the family and is not anticipated to result in increased costs to the agencies.
