SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO SENATE BILL 385

March 6, 2014 - Offered by Senator Leibham.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 2, line 1: delete that line and substitute:
3	"Section 1m. 238.02 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 238.02 (3) (a) and
4	amended to read:
5	238.02 (3) (a) A chief executive officer shall be nominated by the governor
6	board, and with the advice and consent of the senate appointed, to serve at the
7	pleasure of the governor board. The board may delegate to the chief executive officer
8	any powers and duties the board considers proper. The chief executive officer shall
9	receive such compensation as may be determined by the board.
10	Section 1p. 238.02 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:
11	238.02 (3) (b) The governor shall coordinate with the chief executive officer as

if the chief executive officer is the secretary of a department in the executive branch

of state government who is appointed by the governor.".

- 2. Page 2, line 9: delete the material beginning with "executive" and ending
 with "chief operating officer," on line 10 and substitute "operating officer".
 - **3.** Page 2, line 11: delete "all" and substitute "both".
- **4.** Page 2, line 13: delete lines 13 to 16.
