- **1.** Page 47, line 16: substitute "easements, temporary trails" for "temporary trails, easements".
 - **2.** Page 47, line 19: delete lines 19 to 23 and substitute:
- "Section 128e. 443.14 (8) (intro.) of the statutes is repealed. 5
 - **Section 128m.** 443.14 (8) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 443.14 (8) and amended to read:
 - 443.14 (8) An employee of a professional land surveyor registered in this state or authorized to practice under a permit, while working doing surveying work under the supervision of the employer. Such exempt, if the employee shall is not be in responsible charge of the practice of professional land surveying.".
- **3.** Page 48, line 1: delete lines 1 to 4 and substitute: 12
- "Section 131e." 443.14 (8) (d) of the statutes is repealed. 13
