Senator Lassa would like to delete the provision in the budget with reference to chronic alcoholism, drug addiction, psychosis, and active tuberculosis as care needs that qualify a veteran or a veteran's spouse, surviving spouse, or parent for admission to the Veterans Homes at King, Union Grove, and Chippewa Falls. Under current law, in order to be admitted to a veterans home, an individual must have care needs that the veterans home is able to provide within the resources allocated for the care of members of the veterans home, including chronic alcoholism, drug addiction, psychosis, or active tuberculosis. This item would remove the reference to these specific conditions.

1 **AN ACT** ...; **relating to:** the budget.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

VETERANS

Under current law, DVA may admit to a veterans home a person who is a veteran and meets certain other eligibility requirements. One of those eligibility requirements is that the person has care needs that the veterans home is able to provide. The statutes specifically list chronic alcoholism, drug addiction, psychosis, or active tuberculosis as such care needs.

This bill removes the reference in the statutes to chronic alcoholism, drug addiction, psychosis, or active tuberculosis.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the Department of Veterans Affairs (DVA) may admit to a veterans home a person who is a veteran and who meets certain other eligibility requirements. One of those requirements is that the person has care needs that the veterans home is able to provide. (Act 20),

The statutory provision as to this requirement that was in effect prior to the enactment of 2013 Act 20, the biennial budget act, specifically listed chronic alcoholism, drug addiction, psychosis, and active tuberculosis as such care needs. Act 20 removed this list from the statutory provision, and this bill restores the list.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 45.51 (2) (b) 5. of the statutes is amended to read:
45.51 (2) (b) 5. Has care needs that the veterans home is able to provide within the resources allocated for the care of members of the veterans home, including chronic alcoholism, drug addiction, psychosis, or active tuberculosis.
