



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE BILL 416**

February 20, 2014 – Offered by Representative STRACHOTA.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 8: delete “(b) If” and substitute “(b) 1. Except as provided in
3 subd. 2., if”.

4 **2.** Page 2, line 11: after that line insert:

5 “2. School employees are not required to report the pupil’s use of the
6 epinephrine auto-injector under subd. 1. if any of the following applies:

7 a. A physician or emergency medical technician, as defined in s. 256.01 (5),
8 observes the pupil after the pupil uses the epinephrine auto-injector and determines
9 that it is not necessary to call “911” or, if applicable, the telephone number for an
10 emergency medical service provider.

11 b. A school employee knows that a person other than a school employee
12 reported the pupil’s use of the epinephrine auto-injector by calling “911” or, if

1 applicable, the telephone number for an emergency medical service provider, or
2 otherwise contacted the next appropriate level of emergency care.”.
