Sen. Grothman would like a bill drafted requiring DPI to collect data on the cost, benefit level and description of all health care plans in all school districts statewide.

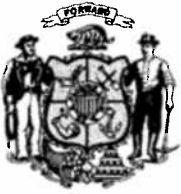

Hi Tracy,

Sen. Grothman appreciates your suggestions in the drafter's notes and has some additions to make a well.

We would like the report to be made annually by DPI and submitted to the governor and to the legislature at large as well as the standing committees.

Also, included in the reported data we would like the total healthcare expenditures by the school district but also the cost amount per benefitted employee (average). I don't know if there is a way to work that into statute language or if that would be up to DPI to construct during their reporting, but if that is possibly to explicitly require the breakdown per employee in statute that would be preferred.

Example:

- West Bend School District spent X amount on health care total for the school district
- West Bend School District spent an average of Y amount per benefitted employee

This will help members get a comparison between school districts especially those districts which differ in size.

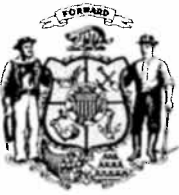

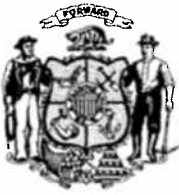
