Under current law, the number of nomination paper signatures required for a candidate for a city-wide office in a 2nd or 3rd class city is not less than 200 nor more than 400 electors. Under this bill, the number of nomination paper signatures x required for a candidate for a city-wide office in a 2nd) or 3rd class city is not less than 100 nor more than 200 electors. class

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 8.10 (3) (j) of the statutes is amended to read: 3

8.10 (3) (j) For city offices in 2nd and 3rd class cities, not less than 200 ± 100 nor 4

more than 400 200 electors for city-wide offices and not less than 20 nor more than

40 electors for alderpersons elected from aldermanic districts. 6
