Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

SB-446 would have no fiscal effect on the PSC, as the rule-making activities — both one-time and regularly scheduled — assigned to the Commission could be absorbed by current staff. The effect on local government is a potential increase in revenues due to the proposed annual fee of \$250,000 for dry cask storage from the utility or person storing spent nuclear fuel within the affected village, town or city boundaries, as well as an additional, annual fee of \$5,000 for each cask stored. Each affected county would receive \$150,000 a year for dry cask storage within their designated boundaries.
