Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill requires the Department to revoke or deny a registration or license for certain entities it regulates if the registrant is certified as delinquent for unemployment insurance (UI) contributions by the Department of Workforce Development (DWD). The Department is to enter into a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the DWD.

The Department currently has an MOU with the Department of Revenue (DOR) for a similar license match related to delinquent taxes. Assuming the MOU the Department enters into with DWD is similar to the MOU already in place with DOR, the efforts to provide the registration/licensing data to DWD should be minimal. Based on experience with the DOR program, the number of licenses affected by revocation is expected to be small. There will some administrative time to establish the program and address potential revocations, but it is expected to be minor.
