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

Aaron,

I have instructions from Rep. Richard's office for an amendment to SB 539/AB 704 for tomorrow's Joint Committee on Finance executive session.

The amendment would do the following:

- Create an appropriation [in 20.395 (1)] for providing an "emergency supplement for the general transportation aid payments for municipalities."
- Provide \$17,000,000 in 2013-14 in this appropriation.
- Sunset the appropriation on June 30, 2015.

- Require DOT to make a payment to each municipality from the new appropriation on the date of the first quarterly payment made under the general transportation aid program occurring after the effective date of the bill.
- Require DOT to calculate the payments to each municipality as follows: (a) divide the municipality's 2014 aid payment under the program by the total amount distributed to municipalities in 2014; and (b) multiply the amount calculated in (a) by the amount in the appropriation.
- Require municipalities to use funds received under the supplement program in 2014 for road repairs associated with damages resulting from the 2013-14 winter.
- Title the program the "2013-14 Winter Emergency Local Road Improvement Initiative"

**SENATE AMENDMENT,
TO SENATE BILL 539**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 1: after "funding" insert ", funding under the general
3 transportation aids program,".

4 **2.** Page 1, line 2: before that line insert:

5 "SECTION 1. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place,
6 insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

7 2013-14 2014-15

8 **20.395 Transportation, department of**

9 (1) AIDS

10 (au) Transportation aids supplement

11 to municipalities, state funds SEG B 17,000,000 -0-

12 **SECTION 2.** 20.395 (1) (au) of the statutes is created to read:

1 20.395 (1) (au) *Transportation aids supplement to municipalities, state funds.* ✓
 2 Biennially, the amounts in the schedule for providing an emergency supplement for
 3 the general transportation aid payments to municipalities under 2013 Wisconsin Act
 4 (this act), section 9145 (1) (b). ✓ No moneys may be encumbered from this
 5 appropriation account after June 30, 2015. ✓

SECTION 9145. Nonstatutory provisions; Transportation

7 (1) 2013-14 WINTER EMERGENCY LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT INITIATIVE. (a) In this
 8 subsection:

- 9 1. "Department" means the department of transportation. ✓
- 10 2. "Municipality" ✓ has the meaning given in section 86.30 (1) (c) ✓ of the statutes.
- 11 3. "Program" means the general transportation aids program under section
 12 86.30 of the statutes. ✓

13 (b) On the date of the department's first quarterly payment under the program
 14 of aids to municipalities occurring after the effective date of this paragraph ✓, the
 15 department shall, from the appropriation under section 20.395 (1) (au) ✓ of the
 16 statutes, as created by this act, make an emergency supplemental payment to each
 17 municipality receiving aids under the program. ✓

18 (c) The department shall calculate the amount of the payment to each
 19 municipality under paragraph (b) ✓ as follows:

- 20 1. The department shall divide the municipality's 2014 aid payment under the
 21 program by the total amount of aid distributed to municipalities in 2014 under the
 22 program. ✓
- 23 2. The department shall multiply the result under ✓ subdivision 1. by
 24 \$17,000,000. ✓

1 (d) A municipality that receives an emergency supplemental payment under
2 paragraph (b) [✓] may use the moneys received only in 2014 and only for highway repairs
3 associated with damages resulting from the 2013–14 winter.” [✓]
