## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates a penalty for which an additional 50% railroad crossing improvement surcharge must be assessed. This assessment is intended to help fund railroad crossing protection improvements. While adding a group of potential violators that could be assessed a railroad crossing improvement assessment may increase the funding available, it is unknown how many pedestrians are likely to violate this crossing restriction and be subject to the railroad crossing improvement assessment.

It is also unknown how increases to penalties of subsequent violations by bicyclists or operators of electric personal assistive mobility devices will impact available funding.
