Elimination of the requirement that the governor approve a proposed rule that was considered at the joint annual spring fish and wildlife rule hearing of the Department of Natural Resources and county meeting of the Wisconsin Conservation Congress and limitation of the scope of the requirement that an economic impact analysis be prepared for such a proposed rule

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2013 SB 608 generally restores the statutory provisions in place prior to the enactment of 2011 Wisconsin Act 21. Act 21 required gubernatorial approval of proposed rules; updated the circumstances under which the preparation of an economic impact analysis of a proposed administrative rule must be prepared; and updated what information must be included in the economic impact analysis. SB 608 eliminates Act 21 provisions only for proposed administrative rules that have been considered at the joint annual spring fish and wildlife rule hearing of the Department of Natural Resources and county meeting of the Wisconsin Conservation Congress.

The Department serves as a clearinghouse for Act 21 provisions for administrative rule approvals and requirements. Because SB 608 would eliminate certain Act 21 requirements for a specific rule, the bill will not impact the workload of the Department and has no state fiscal effect on the Department.
