## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, certain health care providers are required to carry a medical malpractice policy purchased from an insurer authorized to sell insurance in Wisconsin or by a qualifed self-insurer. This bill modifies the requirements to allow health care providers to purchase insurance through a risk retention group domiciled in another state.

The Department of Health Services does not anticipate a fiscal effect on DHS programs as a result of this bill. Any entities who contract with the Department as direct health care providers or as an organizational entity are required to maintain malpractice insurance; that requirement would continue under this bill without a fiscal impact. Department employees in health care professions are covered by the State and therefore this bill would not affect them.
