### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill would result in additional costs incurred by the Department from increased staff time related to the tracking of parking area information, modification of leases, repainting of parking areas, establishment of access aisles and related signage. It is assumed that local governments would incur similar costs as well, but these costs are anticipated to be minor.

Since this bill only applies to parking areas that are initially constructed, reconstructed, resurfaced, or repainted after the effective date of the bill, the exact amount of increased costs in order to comply with the various requirements cannot be determined at this time, as the number of parking areas that will be impacted by the bill is unknown.
