Hi Valirie,

I was working on this request for the redraft of 2011 SB 420 and in reviewing it, I noticed something that Sen. Grothman may want to address. The bill does not specify dates for when the two new members' terms would expire. I think that in order to avoid ambiguity in how these new members would be staggered, Sen. Grothman may want to specify in the bill when he'd like the terms of these new members to expire. From then on they would last four years. Currently the Medical Examining Board has members who serve staggered four-year terms, meaning that they don't all expire in the same year, but they are instead staggered so that each year only a few terms expire and new vacancies occur. The most up to date listing for the Medical Examining Board that we have is attached in a PDF file, but the ones that we don't have marked as confirmed by the senate yet have a little 5 next to them. However, you presumably have access to a more up to date resource on the status of those appointments. Also, the list I have attached does not specify which members are the current public members.

If we don't say when the new terms would expire, it could be ambiguous. So, you may want to have the bill say, for example, that one new member's term expires on July 1, 2015 and one on July 1, 2017.

Please let me know if you have any questions. See attached.

**Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau**

Current law requires three ✓ of the members of the Medical Examining Board ✓ (board), in the Department of Safety and Professional Services, ✓ to be public members. Current law also prohibits the public members from being engaged in any profession or occupation concerned with the delivery of physical or mental health care. This bill increases the number of public members on the board to ✓ five members, and requires that three of the public members of the board be representatives of private sector businesses having at least 100 ✓ employees.

**The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:**

3 SECTION 1. 15.405 (7) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:  
4 15.405 (7) (b) 3. ~~Three~~ Five ✓ public members. ~~Three~~ of the members ✓ appointed  
5 under this subdivision ✓ shall be representatives of private sector businesses having  
6 at least 100 employees. ✓

7 SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.

SENATE BILL 420

1 (1) Notwithstanding section 15.08 (1)✓ of the statutes, the governor may  
 2 provisionally appoint the 2✓ new, additional members to the medical examining board
