1     **Relating to:** proclaiming May 2013 as Motorcycle Awareness Month.

2           Whereas, many thousands of Wisconsin residents and visitors enjoy  
3     motorcycling as an energy-efficient mode of transportation and as an enjoyable  
4     recreational activity; and

5           Whereas, May is nationally recognized as the month motorcycles become more  
6     prevalent on our streets and the need to be aware of their presence is of the utmost  
7     urgency; and

8           Whereas, due to the increased number of motorcycles on the roads and  
9     highways of our state and because motorcycle awareness and safety is a concern to  
10    all, it is appropriate to set aside a time to alert all motorists to the number of  
11    motorcyclists on the roads and to help motorists become aware of the safety concerns  
12    of motorcyclists, especially with regard to sharing the road with motorcycles; and

13          Whereas, this worthwhile observance provides all Wisconsin motorists with an  
14    opportunity to rededicate themselves to the highest standards of highway safety;
