LRB 2279/1 (Senate companion LRB ?/1) will designate May 2013 as Motorcycle Awareness month here in Wisconsin.

Each year, May is recognized nationally as the month that the number of motorcycles on the road begins to increase. Due to the increased number of motorcycles on the roads and highways of our state and because
