2 1. Page 3, line 4: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 3d. 20.445 (1) (gm) of the statutes is created to read:

4 20.445 (1) (gm) *Mining industry jobs training grants.* All moneys credited to

5 this appropriation account under s. 70.395 (1e) (a) for mining skills training grants

6 under s. 106.05 and for mining equipment manufacturing training grants under s.

7 106.35."

8 2. Page 7, line 18: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with  
9 page 8, line 2, and substitute:

10 "SECTION 32d. 70.395 (1e) of the statutes is renumbered 70.395 (1e) (intro.) and

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70.395 (1e) DISTRIBUTION. (intro.) Fifteen days after the collection of the tax under ss. 70.38 to 70.39, the department of administration, upon certification of the department of revenue, shall transfer the amount collected in respect to mines not in operation on November 28, 1981, to the investment and local impact funds, ~~except~~

as follows:

~~SECTION 32e.~~ 70.395-(1e)-(a) of the statutes is created to read:

70.395 (1e) (a) From the amount collected from a person who is issued a permit under s. 295.58, after the payments are made under sub. (2) (d) 1., 2., and 2m., the department of administration shall credit the amount collected from any such person, not to exceed \$83,333 each month or \$2,000,000 total, to the appropriation under s. 20.445 (1) (gm) and shall transfer any amount in excess of \$83,333 each month, or in excess of \$2,000,000 total, as provided under par. (b).

SECTION 32f. 70.395 (1e) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

70.395 (1e) (b) Except as provided under par. (a), <sup>that</sup> the department of administration shall transfer 60 percent of the amount collected from each person extracting ferrous metallic minerals in this state to the investment and local impact fund and 40 percent of the amount collected from any such person to the general fund”.

3. Page 12, line 22: after that line insert:

SECTION 43d. 106.05 of the statutes is created to read:

106.05 Mining skills training grants. From the appropriation account under s. 20.445 (1) (gm), the department, in consultation with the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation, shall award a grant annually of not more than \$500,000 to Cooperative Educational Service Agency Number 12 or to an

1 organization operating a skills improvement apprenticeship program that is  
2 authorized to administer the operating engineers certification program and to  
3 provide training in the operation of heavy equipment, for the purposes of  
4 establishing, funding, and facilitating cross-training partnership programs  
5 between that agency and that organization.

6 SECTION 43e. 106.35 of the statutes is created to read:

7 **106.35 Mining equipment manufacturing training grants.** From the  
8 appropriation account under s. 20.445 (1) (gm), the department, in consultation with  
9 the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation, shall award a grant annually of  
10 not more than \$500,000 to Cooperative Educational Service Agency Number 1 or to  
11 an organization operating an economic and workforce development center in the  
12 southeastern area of this state to establish, fund, and facilitate cross-training  
13 partnership programs between that service agency and that organization for the  
14 purpose of establishing classroom curriculum and hands-on job training programs  
15 that provide individuals with the opportunity to receive instruction relating to the  
16 performance of manufacturing jobs in facilities in that area that are involved in  
17 producing equipment and products related to the mining industry.”.
