Hi Becky –

Andy in Rep. Clark's office indicated that you had some questions about the exceptional waters amendment we'd like prepared for the mining bill. I apologize if my term "extraordinary waters" was confusing – clearly, I meant "exceptional" resource waters. Here's what Rep. Mason wants: He would like a simple amendment to the sub (whatever version will be before the Assembly on Thursday) that simply prevents all exceptional resource waters and outstanding resource waters from being exempted or excluded from protections– in other words, those waters should be off-limits for any discharge (including nonpoint) that might result from mining.

Carl Sindebrand is the attorney we have been working with on this amendment. He says that he knows you well and if you have further questions about what this amendment should do, please feel free to contact him directly for clarification.
