



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 10,  
TO SENATE BILL 1**

March 6, 2013 – Offered by Representatives BERNARD SCHABER, BARCA, BARNES, BERCEAU, CLARK, DOYLE, GENRICH, GOYKE, HEBL, HESSELBEIN, JOHNSON, OHNSTAD, PASCH, POPE, RICHARDS, RINGHAND, SHANKLAND, SMITH, C. TAYLOR, WACHS, WRIGHT, ZAMARRIPA, MASON, YOUNG, BEWLEY, DANOU, ZEPNICK, KOLSTE, BILLINGS and HULSEY.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute  
2           amendment 2, as follows:

3           **1.** Page 179, line 4: delete lines 4 to 9 and substitute:

4           “(4) (a) The department may issue a stop order to an operator, requiring an  
5           immediate cessation of mining, in whole or in part, at any time that the department  
6           determines that the continuance of mining constitutes an immediate and  
7           substantial threat to public health and safety or the environment.

8           (b) If no hearing on the stop order was held before issuance of the order, the  
9           department shall schedule a hearing on the stop order, to be held within 5 days after  
10          issuance and shall incorporate notice of the hearing in the copy of the order served  
11          on the operator. The department also shall give notice to any other persons who  
12          previously requested notice of such proceedings.
