1. Amendment 1: Restore funding to Recycling Fund

In 2011, Governor Walker proposed eliminating the recycling fund from the state budget. Fortunately, a bipartisan effort by legislators restored 60% of that funding. However, the end result was a 40% cut in recycling funding. In 2010 alone, over \$132 million worth of metals were buried in Wisconsin's landfills:

This amendment would restore the \$11 million that was cut from the recycling fund in 2011, an investment that will go toward recycling up to \$132 million worth of metals annually, including over \$41 million worth of ferrous iron.
