ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 14

February 26, 2013 – Offered by Committee on Workforce Development.

At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

- **1.** Page 3, line 18: delete "From" and substitute "(a) From".
- **2.** Page 3, line 20: delete lines 20 to 22 and substitute "workforce training programs that help meet local needs for supporting sectors of the economy with a documented skills gap or a high workforce shortage, which could include manufacturing, energy, information technology, skilled trades, and health care.
- (b) An organization that is awarded a grant under this subsection may use the grant for activities that address the development of individuals prior to entering the workforce and for incumbent workforce training, which activities and training could include any one or more of the following:
 - 1. Job training scholarships based on local labor market needs.
- 2. Building or infrastructure construction.
- 13 3. Equipment and material purchases.

4. The hiring of trainers.

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- 5. Development in partnership with industry of workforce training curricula, based on industry standards, that lead to certificates or degrees.
 - 6. Career support services, including job placement and business recruitment.
 - (c) In reviewing grant applications under this subsection, the department shall consider the speed by which the activities specified in those applications could meet training and employment needs and shall give a preference in awarding those grants to projects that seek to eliminate waiting lists for courses pertaining to jobs with high employment demand. As a condition of receiving a grant under this subsection,".
