Gordon,

I apologize, but we have a late-breaking change to our request. We'd now like 3 amendments, 1 is the same as I'd requested, but the other has been divided and has a bit of a different flavor.

1. The amendment I'd asked for before using the grant structure laid out in 2011 AB 398 to provide a framework for how the grants would be awarded.
2. Explicitly include "awarding grants" in 106.27 (2)(b) so that it is clear they can consult on awarding grants as well. This is so when the GOP amendment (0114/2) is added, it will be clear that WTCS and WEDC get to consult on both the pre-rulemaking and post-rulemaking, award-granting periods, not just in the rulemaking process.
3. State that, if WTCS applies for funding, WTCS is the preferred provider of training grant projects or be given priority for training grants. We don't want them obligated to be the priority provider if a particular project wouldn't make sense for the tech schools to work on, but if they apply, they should be given preference.

Cathlene,

Our office would like to request 2 amendments for the Tuesday Exec of the Assembly Workforce Dev Committee on AB 14. We believe these will be due right away on Monday to meet a 10am deadline for a 24 hour amendment rule.

1. A. Require that DWD WTCS and WEDC share responsibility over determining who receives grant funding.
B. State that WTCS is the preferred provider of training grant projects or be given priority for training grants.

2. Use the grant structure laid out in 2009 AB 398 to provide a framework for how the grants would be awarded. DWD can maintain the rulemaking authority granted in the bill, but these provisions would be put in statute to guide the purposes grant money is awarded for and how it is used by organizations.
