Include language provided in LRB-0939/2 under 108.062 (2) (L), which requires a plan to “Include a statement signed by the authorized agent of any representative of the employees included in the work–share program to the effect that the representative has approved the plan whenever approval is required under sub. (13).”

Also include language listed under 108.062 (13), which states, “APPROVAL BY EMPLOYEE REPRESENTATIVE. If there is a single representative representing some or all of the employees who are included in a work–share plan, the plan is subject to approval of that representative.”

February 22, 2013 - Offered by Senators LEHMAN and JAUCH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 8, line 8: after that line insert:

3 “(km) Include a statement signed by the authorized agent of any representative
4 of the employees included in the work-share program to the effect that the
5 representative has approved the plan whenever approval is required under sub.
6 (13).”

7 2. Page 10, line 16: after that line insert:

8 “(13) APPROVAL BY EMPLOYEE REPRESENTATIVE. If there is a single representative
9 representing some or all of the employees who are included in a work-share plan, the
10 plan is subject to approval of that representative.”

11 (END)
