Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

If enacted, Senate Bill 55 would add utility facilities owned by a joint local water authority to the group of municipal utility facilities that is subject to state cost sharing when relocation or replacement of the facilities is required by the construction of a freeway. The bill also adds joint local water authorities to the group of local governmental units that are eligible to participate in the safe drinking water loan program.

The fiscal estimate on the Department of Administration is indeterminate as there is only one joint local water authority in the state and it is unknown whether or not the authority would actually apply for or would just be eligible to apply for a safe drinking water loan in the future.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications
