The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5	SECTION 1. 45.03 (13) (o) of the statutes is created to read:
6	45.03 (13) (o) Provide verification to the department of transportation of the
7	information required under s. 343.14 (2) (j).
8	SECTION 2. 343.14 (2) (j) of the statutes is created to read:
9	343.14 (2) (j) A statement as to whether the applicant is a veteran, as defined
10	in s. 45.01 (12), and, if so, whether the applicant wishes to have his or her veteran

status indicated on the license or identification card. If the applicant has indicated
that he or she is a veteran and wishes to have his or her veteran status indicated on
the license or identification card, the applicant shall provide verification from the
department of veterans affairs or a county veterans service officer that the applicant
is a veteran.

SECTION 3. 343.17 (3) (a) 15. of the statutes is created to read:

343.17 (3) (a) 15. If the person is a veteran, has indicated that he or she wishes
to have his or her veteran status indicated on the license, and has provided the
verification required under s. 343.14 (2) (j), an indication that the person is a veteran.
SECTION 7. 343.50 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

11 343.50 (4) APPLICATION. The application for an identification card shall include any information required under ss. 85.103 (2) and 343.14 (2) (a), (b), (bm), (br), (em), 1213and (es), and (j), and such further information as the department may reasonably 14require to enable it to determine whether the applicant is entitled by law to an 15identification card. Except with respect to renewals described in s. 343.165 (4) (d) 16 or renewals by mail or electronic means as authorized under sub. (6), and except as 17provided in sub. (4g), the department shall, as part of the application process for original issuance or renewal of an identification card, take a digital photograph 18 19 including facial image capture of the applicant to comply with sub. (3). 20Misrepresentations in violation of s. 343.14 (5) are punishable as provided in s. 21343.14 (9).
