**SENATE AMENDMENT ,
TO SENATE BILL 206**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 10, line 5: after "heartbeat." insert "The pregnant woman may have
3 a designee accompany her into the facility ^{in which an ultrasound is to be performed} and during the ultrasound and she or her
4 designee may video tape or make an audio recording of the ultrasound and any part
5 of her visit to the facility from the time of her entrance to the facility. No person may
6 obstruct or prevent a pregnant woman from having a person accompany her in a
7 facility in which an ultrasound is to be performed. No person may obstruct or prevent
8 a pregnant woman or her designee from video taping or audio recording the
9 ultrasound or any portion of her visit to the facility in which an ultrasound is to be
10 performed."

11 **2.** Page 10, line 24: after that line insert:

12 "SECTION 10r. 253.10 (6) (ag) of the statutes is created to read:

1 253.10 **(6)** (ag) The woman on whom an abortion is to be performed or
2 attempted, or is performed or attempted, may bring a claim for damages against a
3 physician for exerting undue pressure on her to view the screen during the
4 ultrasound.”.✓

5 **3.** Page 11, line 11: before “or (am)” insert “, (ag),”.✓

6 **4.** Page 11, line 12: before “or (am)” insert “, (ag),”.✓

7 (END) plain
